1. The Rules

- 1.1 Racing will take place under the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the Prescriptions of the RYA, the Sailing Instructions of the Datchet Water Sailing Club, and the BIFFA Rules and Class Championship Regulations. If there is conflict between this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, then the Sailing Instructions shall prevail.
- 1.2 Advertising, this event has been designated Category C in accordance with ISaF regulation 20.3.1 (b) though the restrictions of the International Flying Fifteen Association Rules 17.2 will also apply

2. Conditions of Entry

- 2.1. Entry is open to any competitor who is a member of the BIFFA (or other National Flying Fifteen Association affiliated to Flying Fifteen International). The race committee may require proof of membership. The regatta is open to all Flying Fifteens with a valid measurement certificate, which are Open, Silver and Classic subdivisions of the Flying Fifteen Class
- 2.2. Competitors under the age of 18 years at the time of the event shall be required to complete and lodge the parental/guardian's consent form included in the entry form with the Race Committee prior to the start of racing.
- 2.3. Competitors should note that BIFFA and Datchet Water Sailing Club implement the RYA Racing Charter and that they [competitors] will be required to undertake to sail in compliance with the Charter if you have signed up to the Charter.
- 2.4. which can be found at the front of the RYA rule book (Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008)

3. Responsibility

- 3.1 The safety of a boat and her entire management including insurance shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/person in charge who must ensure that the boat and crew are adequate to face the conditions that may arise in the course of the race. Neither the sailing instructions nor any inspection of the boat limits or reduces the absolute responsibility of the owner/person in charge for the crew, the boat and her management.
- 3.2 The race organisers shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury howsoever caused to the owner/person in charge or crew, as a result of their taking part in the race or races. Moreover, every owner/person in charge warrants the suitability of the boat for the race or races.
- 3.3 It shall be the sole responsibility of those sailing each boat to decide whether or not to start or to continue to race.
- 3.4 Boats shall be insured for a minimum of £2,000,000 Third Party Liability.

4. Entry Fee

The Entry fee for all competitors including members of Datchet Water SC will be £30.

5. Entry Procedure

- 5.1 Competitors may enter (i) in advance by downloading the entry form from the DWSC website <http://www.dwsc.co.uk/> and forwarding it with the appropriate fee to the Club at the address above, or (ii) from 10:00 hrs on Saturday 30th January 2009. Sailing Instructions will be issued on registration.
- 5.2.1 All boats shall have a valid measurement certificate which may be required to be shown on registration.
- 5.3 Competitors should not be able to get sails measured on arrival unless they have made advance arrangements with a measurer.

6. Schedule of Races

- 6.1 5 races are scheduled, of which 1 must be completed to constitute a series. It is the intention that 3 races will be sailed on the Saturday and 2 on the Sunday, but the Race Committee may in its absolute discretion sail fewer or more races on any day.
- 6.2 The warning signal for Race 1 on Saturday 30th January 2009 will be not before 11:55 hrs.
- 6.3 The courses that may be sailed and how they are indicated to competitors will be set out in the sailing instructions.

7. Scoring System

- 7.1 The Low Points Scoring System set out in RRS Appendix A will apply.
- 7.2 Points for race ties will not be divided. This changes Appendix A7
- 7.3. 1 race must be completed to constitute a valid series.
- 7.4 The following discards will apply:
- If fewer than 3 races are sailed, no discard will be allowed;
 - If 3 or more races are sailed, 1 discard will be allowed

8. Berthing

Boats shall be kept in their assigned place in the boat park.

9. Support Boats

Support boats are not allowed.

10. Prizes

Prizes may be awarded for the first 3 places in the Open Fleet, and in the Silver and Classic sections dependant on the entries received.

11. Safety

The Sailing Instructions will require all competitors to wear adequate personal buoyancy at all times while racing. Neither a wetsuit nor a drysuit constitute adequate personal buoyancy. In addition wetsuits or drysuits shall be worn by all competitors while racing. This changes Rule 40.

12. Marketing and Promotion

Competitors automatically grant to the organising authority without payment the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television of or relating to the event.
