

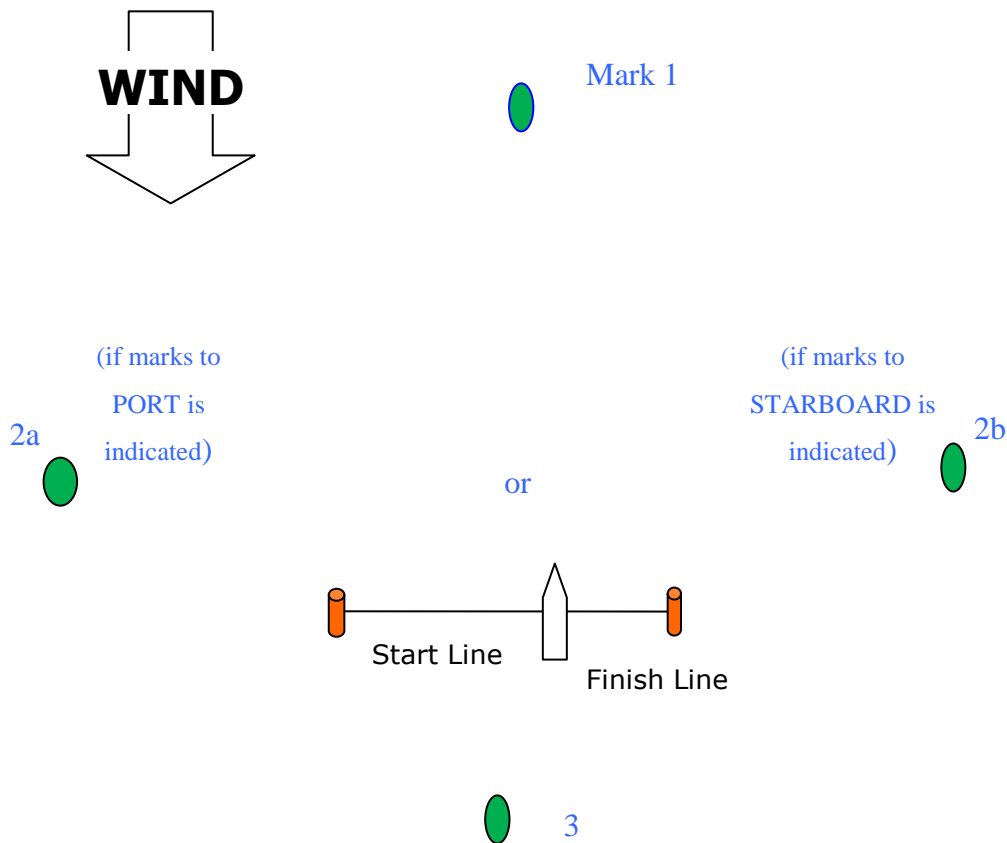
## DWSC CHANGES TO SUNDAY SAILING FORMAT

From Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> May 2010 we are introducing a new course system for Sunday Racing. The basis of this is that there will be two permanently laid triangles of three inflatable buoys – one set **BLUE** and the other set **ORANGE**.

The committee boat will define the course by

1. flying a **RED** flag to indicate PORT Rounding (counter-clockwise) or a **GREEN** flag to indicate STARBOARD Rounding (Clockwise)
2. flying an **ORANGE** or **BLUE** Triangular flag to indicate whether we are using the Orange or Blue Buoys.

Both flags will be flown one above the other at rear of the committee boat.



The main change to the course is that the Start and Finish line are now in the middle of the beat. A typical Triangle/Sausage Course (e.g. Lasers, Flying Fifteens and Fast Handicap) will be Start, 1, 2, 3, 1, 3, 1, 2, 3, Finish. A typical Windward Leeward Course (e.g. Asymmetrics) will be Start, 1, 3, 1, 3, 1, 3, Finish.

The Start or Finish Line is NOT a gate for the intermediate laps.
